Doctor in Psychology, with background in Biological Sciences and Cognitive Neuroscience. I am currently working at Universidad Europea de Valencia, teaching in the Faculty of Health Sciences, and also as a postdoctoral researcher at the Polytechnic University of Valencia in Spain using neurophysiological measures and artificial intelligence to assess the impact of social media on user's physiological state. I am also a visiting research fellow at King's College London in the UK and an honorary researcher at the NHS, where I investigate gambling disorder. In my last postdoctoral fellowship at the University of Valencia I investigated the potential of virtual reality to improve the assessment of problematic gambling behaviour.
