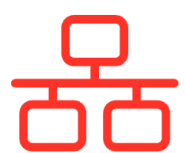

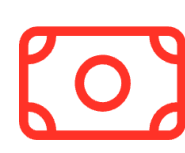

- Minimum grade: **High Merit (≥ 8.0).**
- Explicit sustainability objectives
- Any dimension: environmental, social, economic, technological or governance.

- Executive summary with objectives and motivation (max. 1 page)
- Infographic summary of the project

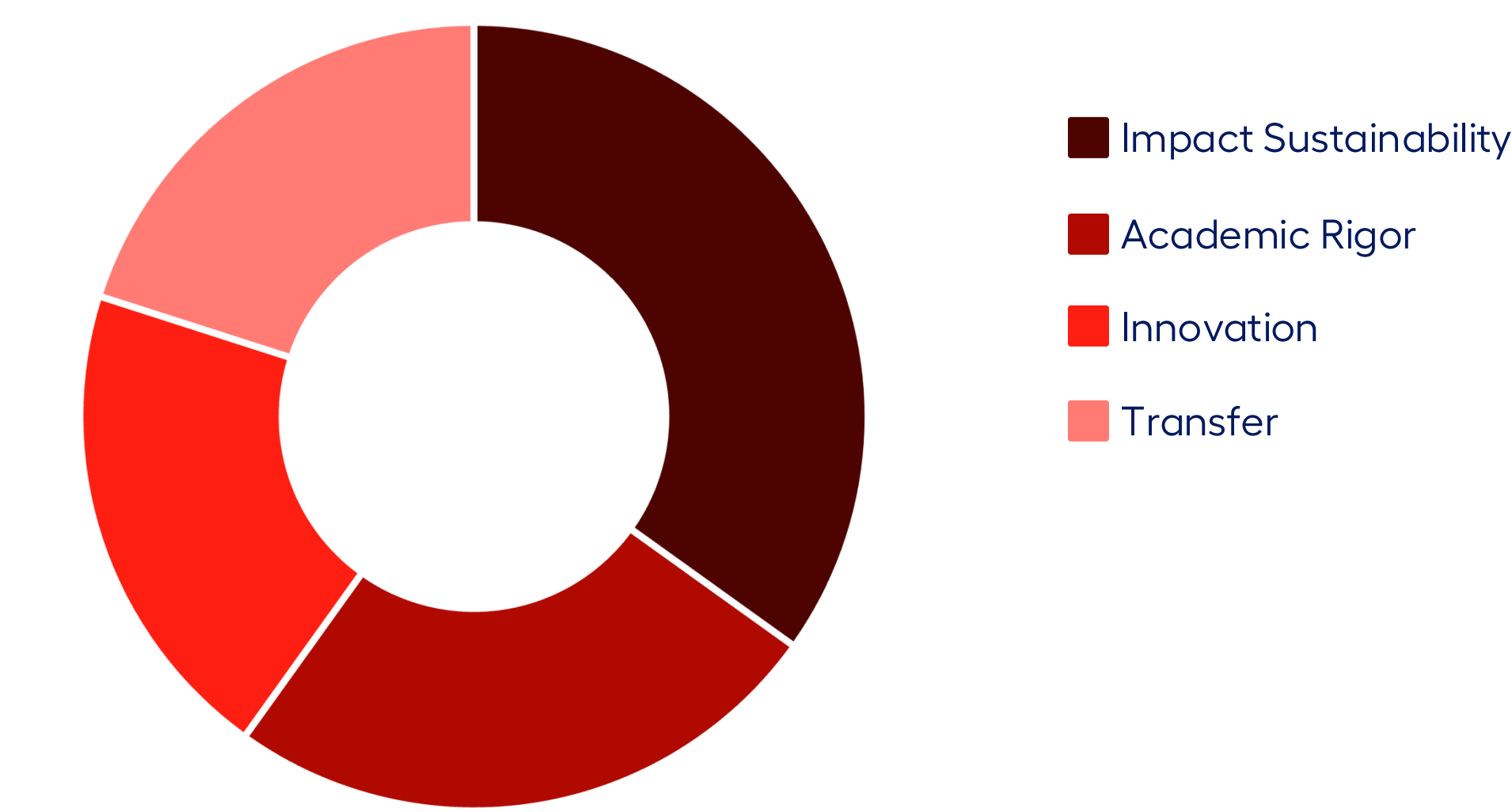
