Continuing upon arriving from China to Macau in 2022 by enrolling to an on-line PhD program at Universidad Católica de Córdoba (Argentina), the PhD dissertation was defended last December 2024 at Universidad de Salamanca (Spain), being recommended for the yearly award by the PhD Tribunal.
